

TRILLS AND THRILLS TRIP

Dear 8th Grade Band Parent,

The 8th Grade Band will be participating in the *Trills and Thrills Festival* at Johnsburg High School, Johnsburg, IL on Friday, May 12th from 7:15 a.m. to approximately 6:45 p.m. Students will be performing for adjudicators at 9:00 a.m. After the performance, we will get back onto the bus and travel to Six Flags Great America, Gurnee, IL, for the remainder of the day. We will leave the park at 5:15 p.m.

- Students should arrive at RMS at 7:15 a.m. The bus will leave RMS at 7:30 a.m.
- Students will need to bring a CASH CARD for meals and souvenirs. Six Flags is now all cashless. See attached letter for explanation. Students may bring a sack lunch if they do not wish to eat at the park. However, they will have to leave the park and re-enter since no food or beverage can be brought into the park.
- All festival fees, entrance to the park, and transportation fees have been generously donated by the Braves Band Boosters. Students who did NOT participate in the fruit sale fundraiser are asked to pay \$10.00 toward the cost of the bus. Make checks payable to Braves Band Boosters.
- Students must wear their band polo shirt and jeans or black pants to the festival. They may change into shorts after the performance if the weather is hot, but we ask that the band shirt be worn at the park. We will follow the dress code printed in the district handbook. Please refer to it to make sure that your student is in compliance. We will go to Great America rain or shine so students should dress according to the weather.
- We will be traveling in a chartered bus with a DVD player. PG-13 movies may be shown.
- CELL PHONES OR ANY OTHER ELECTRONIC DEVICES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED DURING THE PERFORMANCE. Each device must be turned off until after the performance. It is the responsibility of the student to take proper care of the cell phone or device at Great America. We are not responsible for lost or damaged devices.
- Chaperones for the trip will be: Mrs. Boelte, Mrs. Hansen, and other band parents as needed. Each chaperone will be in charge of a small group of students. All students must check in with their chaperone at the designated time and place. There is no cost for chaperones.

Please take the time to fill out the final permission slip and medical information form. If you have any special needs or concerns, please communicate them to Mrs. Boelte so we can be sure to have proper medication if needed.

I will be talking to the students about appropriate behaviors that need to be displayed throughout the trip. Please remind your child that his or her behavior is a reflection of the school and that they should be responsible and respectful.

PLEASE NOTE: STUDENTS WITH CONDUCT AND/OR ELIGIBILITY ISSUES MUST HAVE PERMISSION FROM MRS. CROPP AND MR. KAUFMAN IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE.

Sack lunch if you want one - water bottle

Mask/face covering if desired

SIX FLAGS IS NOW ALL CASHLESS - PLEASE READ!

Six Flags is cashless for this season. They will not accept cash as a form of payment for anything. Six Flags accepts card and mobile payments only at all locations including restaurants, retail stores and games. You can pay for purchases with Visa, Mastercard, American Express, Discover, Apple Pay, Google Pay, or a debit card.

Cash can be converted to a prepaid Visa debit card within the park at one of their ready stations. This prepaid Visa debit card is only good within the park, thus any remaining balance on the card cannot be used for any purchases outside Six Flags. If there is any remaining balance, the student cannot get it refunded. There may be a service fee to get one of Six Flags prepaid Visa debit cards. Food can also be ordered and paid for via Six Flags mobile app, however do not forget to tie a form of payment to the account the student will use to order food.

It may be wise for parents to purchase a Visa or Mastercard gift card from their bank or store to send with their child so they do not lose any money that would be left on one of Six Flags prepaid debit cards. If the parent does get a gift card and the student has a cell phone, please have the parent remind their child not store the card directly against their phone, it may erase the information on the magnetic strip rendering the card useless.
